

Location and structure of the laboratory

The Research Center for Respiratory Pathologies (french acronym "CEPR"), has a double affiliation: Inserm (UMR 1100) and University François Rabelais. This multidisciplinary academic laboratory is located, as shown in the figure below, on the campus of the Faculty of Medicine and the university hospital Bretonneau in Tours.

The CEPR was created on 1 January 2012 and is headed by Dr. Mustapha Si-Tahar (DR2 Inserm). It is linked to two Inserm institutes ("ITMOs"): "Physiopathology, Metabolism, Nutrition" and "Technologies for Health".

Since then, the INSERM 1100 UMR is made up of 3 teams.
